Uploading published papers in ResearchGate and other similar sites is highly recommended to increase visibility and number of citations.

IOP indexed full papers for the International Congress

- Indonesian chapter mentioned that its members are more encouraged to participate if the
 international conference offer the opportunity to publish IOP Scopus Indexed full papers.
 Thus, ISSAAS Congress 2022 Indonesia published an IOP Scopus Indexed conference
 proceeding with 60 full papers in April 2023.
- Upon consultation with other chapters, it was clarified that only Indonesian members require IOP Scopus indexed full papers to receive more points (i.e. IOP 30 points, ISSAAS 15 points). Other chapter members only require Scopus indexed papers for participation.
- In case the ISSAAS Congress host wishes to offer IOP Scopus, the IOP contract will be made by the host chapter. It should be noted that IOP requires a minimum of 40 full papers.

Scopus Indexed Journal of ISSAAS

- Members are always welcome to submit their full manuscript to J. ISSAAS.
- A special issue with title of the international congress may also be published within six months after the international congress. Tentative schedule and details for abstract and full paper submission, review process by chapter and technical editor assistance are required.
